Y4Life High School Leadership Retreat

Open to all Lutheran high school students and Y4Life Teams, youth learn basic techniques and practices for speaking from a Gospel-motivated perspective, discover how to build an effective leadership team, and begin planning for the coming year.

Y4Life College Leadership Retreat

Open to college students on Lutheran campuses or those connected with Lutheran campus ministries, students learn about the nine characteristics of a healthy Life Team and are given practical ways to establish a consistent mission and maintain a Gospel-motivated approach to life ministry. Participants will also discover how to zero in on appropriate life missions for their communities and exchange ideas and techniques.



Future Church Worker Life Ministry Training

Our Life Ministry Training is designed to help future church workers learn the importance of life ministry and give them ways to address life issues, not only while they are still students but also in their future occupations. These sessions are taught in college classrooms and supplement goals for mission and ministry on Lutheran college and university campuses.

Y4Life Servant Events are weekend-long "mini-mission trips" designed to help high school and college students learn about why it is important to be 4Life and where they can go to make a difference 4Life in their own community.
