


is the use of 2 medications to end a pregnancy.

Mifepristone, taken first, stops progesterone production by the mother. This causes the uterine wall to thin, and the fetus can no longer remain implanted or receive nutrients.

Misoprostol, taken later at home, causes contractions to expel the fetus from the uterus through the vagina.

It is currently used through 10 weeks' gestation

It accounted for 39 % of all abortions in the US in 2017,

up from **29**% in 2014 and from 5% in 2001.



Surgical abortion

ends a pregnancy by killing and removing the fetus with surgical tools.

There are several types of surgical abortion; the method chosen depends on how far along the mother is.

Through the first trimester, the abortion occurs by suctioning the fetus out after dilating the cerivix.

From week 13 and on, forceps are necessary for dismemberment because the fetus is too developed to be removed through suction.

Partial-birth abortion, which involves delivering the baby alive and then snipping the spinal cord, is not currently legal in the U.S.

Often, other chemicals are used to assist with the abortion as well.

11.7% of abortions happen in the second and third trimester in the US.


