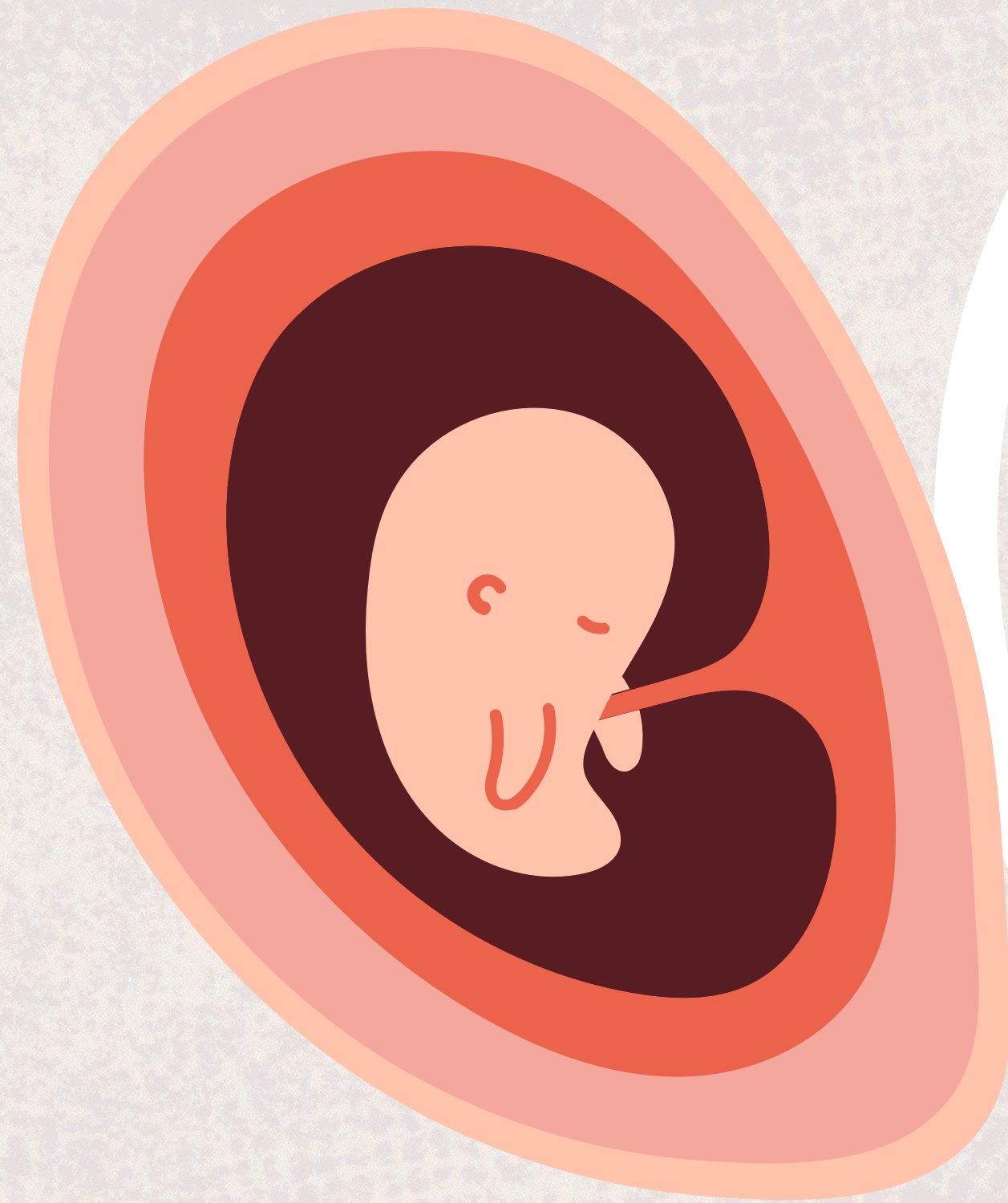

Baby John & Baby Jesus

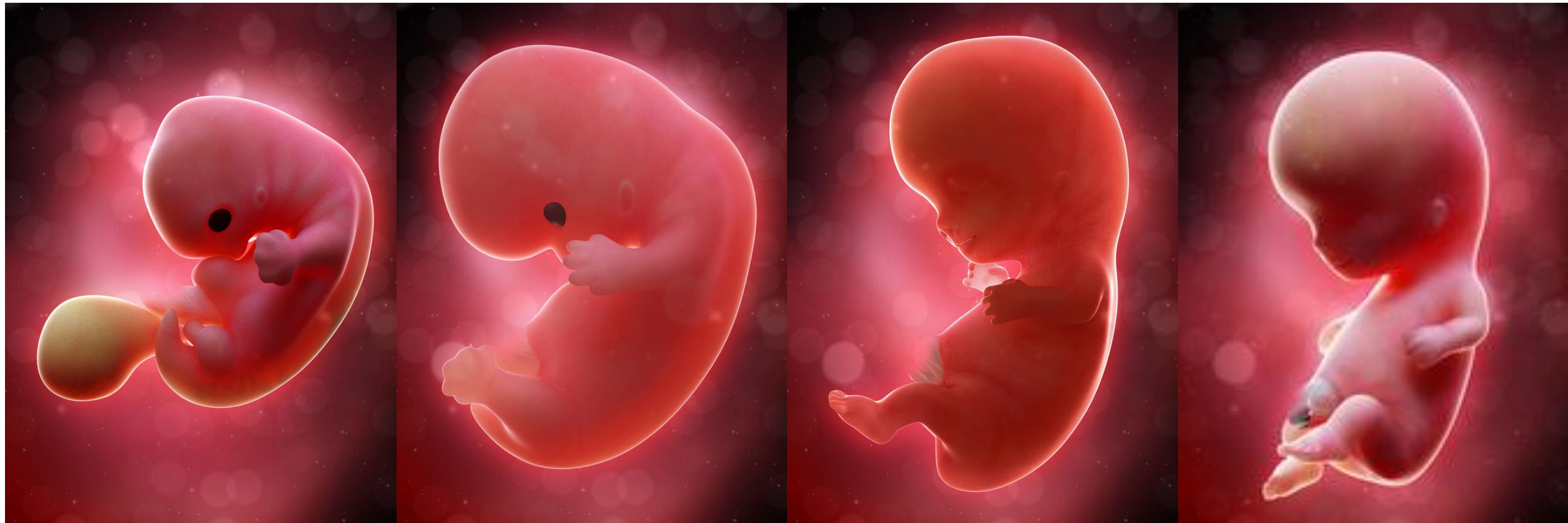


Elizabeth's unborn baby, John, was aware of baby Jesus when Mary was carrying Him.

Fingers can open and close.

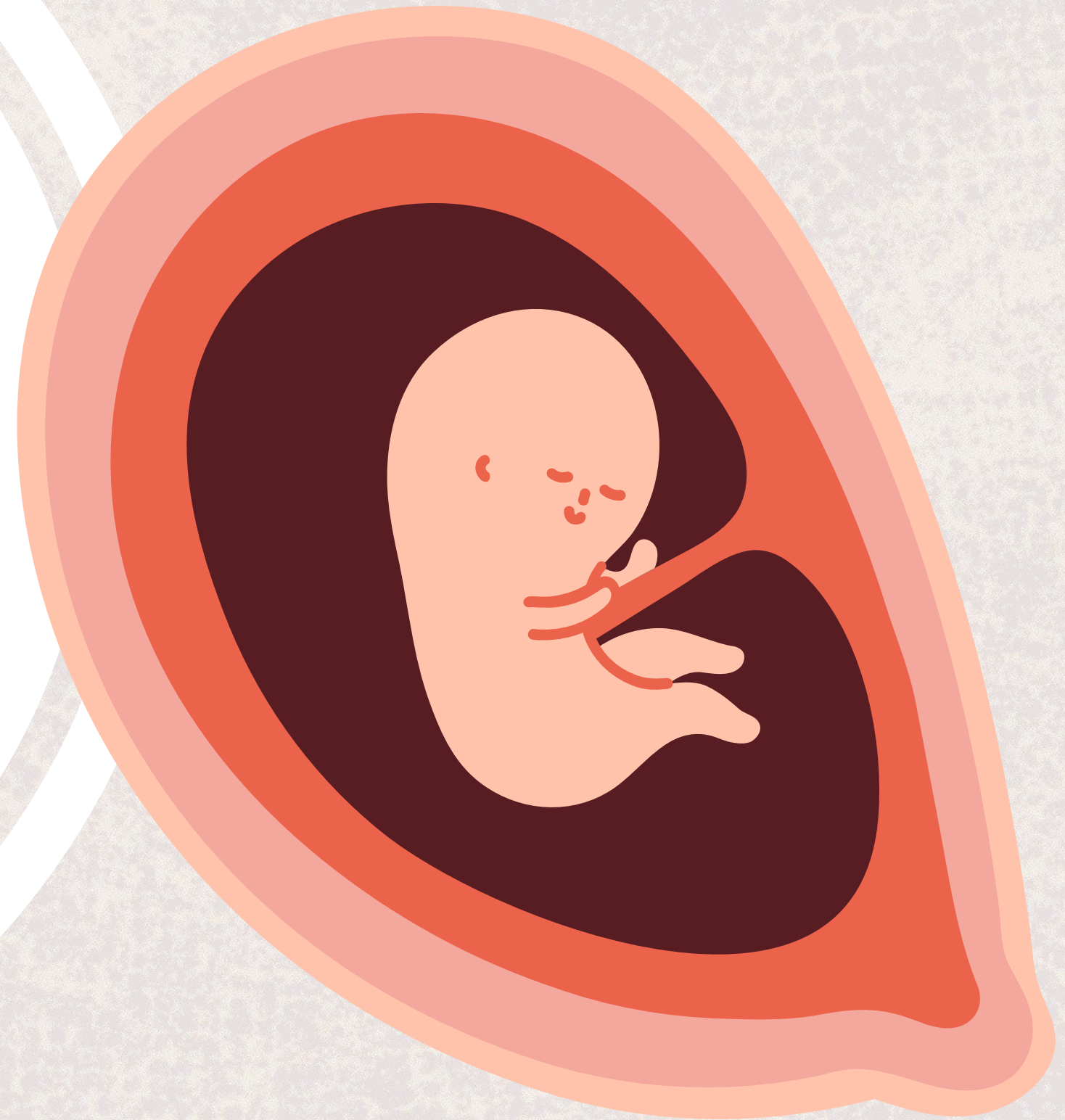
Toes can curl.

Baby can swallow.

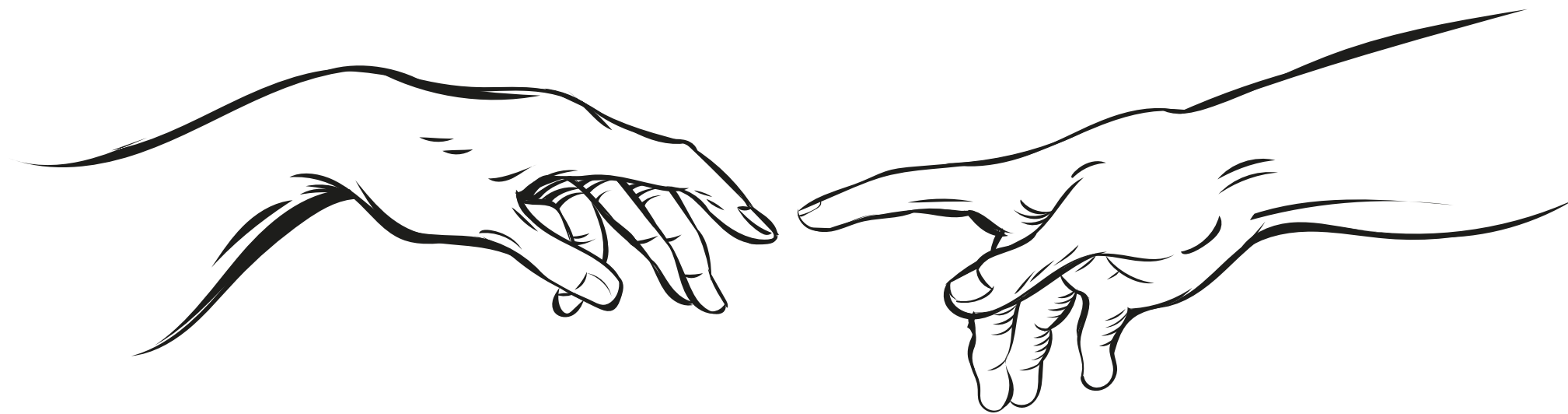
Baby feels and responds to touch and pain.

Can make facial expressions

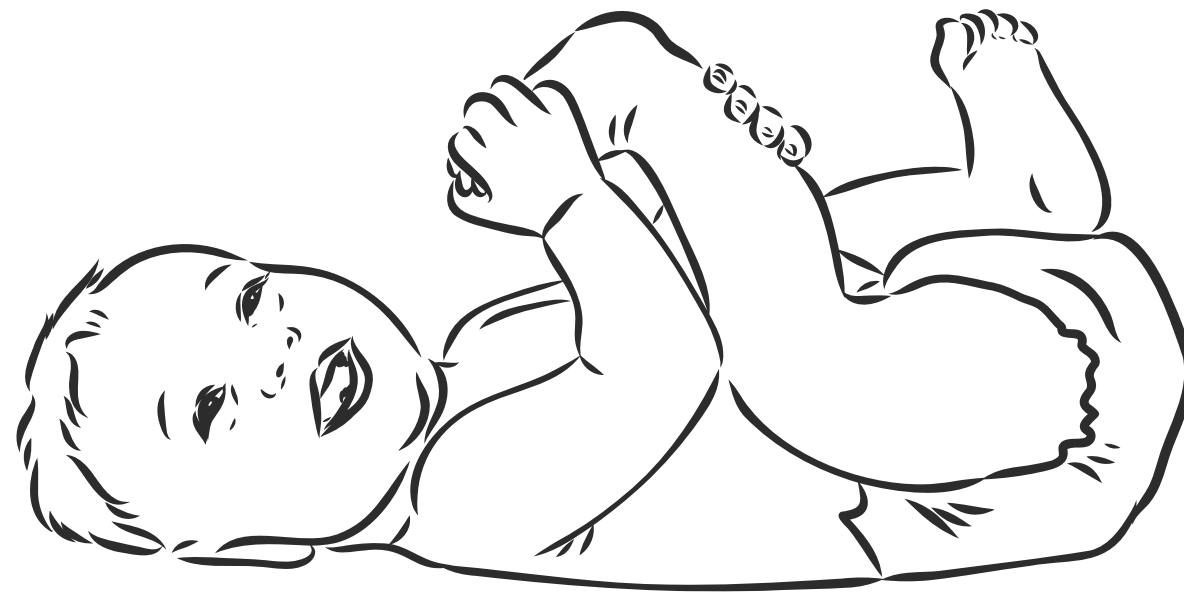
Over half-way through pregnancy

Sweat glands are working.

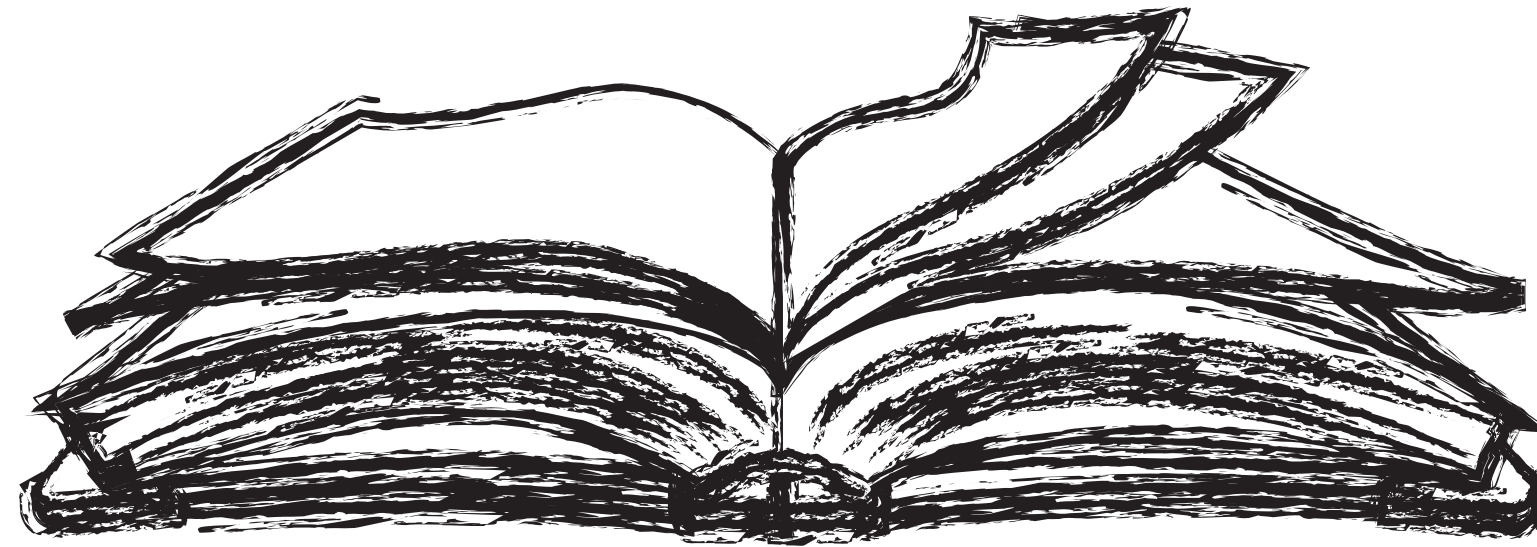
Baby can hear you.
