Life Issues As of a 2024 report:

527 babies in the U.S. were diagnosed with Trisomy 13, 1,101 were diagnosed with Trisomy 18, and 5,713 were diagnosed with Trisomy 21.

There are three types of Down syndrome -


Trisomy 21, Translocation Down syndrome, and Mosaic Down syndrome. Trisomy 21 is the most common type. In Trisomy 21, each cell in the body has three separate copies of chromosome 21. In Translocation, the extra 21st chromosome is attached to a different chromosome. In Mosaic, some cells have fewer than three copies of chromosome 21, but other cells have the typical two copies.
