# 1 • Remain in the Word

Remember our God is the God of Life, and His Word is full of examples of how He preserves, protects, and provides for His people. From the beginning of Genesis, God shows how important humans are in His creation; He takes a whole day to hand-form Adam and Eve. And though God speaks all other life into existence, He gets His hands dirty when He forms the pinnacle of His creation: humankind. God loves all life; in fact, He loves humankind so much that He sent His Son to die for ALL HUMAN LIFE. This makes ALL HUMAN LIFE important, valuable, and meaningful.



Remember, **YOU are made 4 LIFE**, and Christ's death brings **LIFE 4 YOU**. All life is important because it has been **created** and **redeemed** by God. As a believer, you have been **called** to faith in Christ and are made to be His Life Messenger!

## 2•Start Your Own Y4Life Team

*What is a Y4Life Team?* A **Y4Life** Team is a group of youth who want to publicly support life at all stages and who speak to support life in a Gospel-motivated way. They educate themselves and others about life issues and engage in life-affirming activities in their high schools, communities, and nation.



There are only four things a **Y4Life** Team needs:

- Enthusiastic 4 Life teens
- An adult leader (preferably a teacher or chaplain)
- A name (Hint: **Y4Life**...)
- A desire to be a Gospel-motivated voice 4 Life

# 3 • Participate in Life-Affirming Activities

Becoming a Life Messenger is easy. Contact [cori@y4life.org](mailto:cori@y4life.org) for **Gospel-motivated training** and then begin planning your first event! Events fall into one or more categories: **service, celebration, worship, or education**. A service project, such as a clothing drive, supports life; a celebration, such as a community baby shower, rejoices over life; a worship service, such as a Life Chapel, affirms that God is the Creator of life; and an educational event teaches students about life issues.
